### STEP 1: Pick a Student Government (Student Senate) Position

In addition, <u>ALL positions</u> attend to the shared matters of equity, diversity & inclusion, student conduct & rights, access, technology, student well-being, sustainability, and student success.

#### Leadership Team (Elected by the Student Body)

#### **President**

Upholds the mission, values and goals of the BCAS Board. Also provides leadership, direction and oversight for the BCAS board. They're a liaison to our college's faculty, staff, and administrative leadership teams.

#### Vice President of Internal Affairs

Assists the President with leadership, direction, and oversight for the BCAS board. It also helps the Student Senate Advisor with the Student Advocacy Program to ensure that student voices are heard on campus-wide decision-making committees.

#### Student Trustee

Serves as the liaison between the student body and the district's Board of Trustees. Represents the student voice in district-wide decision making, planning and staying up to date on the college's planning and initiatives.

#### **Business Affairs**

Assists the AS Advisor and Student Life Secretary. Oversees the general BCAS budget and BCAS grants program that provides funding for clubs, campus department projects, events, and travel.

#### Senators (Appointed by the Leadership Team)

#### **Student Services Senators: Enrollment (2 positions)**

Focus on matters related to admissions, financial aid, veterans' resources, career and academic success, job placement, and counseling.

#### Student Services Senators: Student Life (2 positions)

Focus on matters related to (but not limited to) Student equity, clubs, campus events, orientation, student conduct/rights/responsibilities, student centers, and support centers.

#### Student Services Senators: Student Success (2 positions)

Focus on matters related to (but not limited to) disabled student services, safe place and wellness, Inspiring Scholars, health center, student success program, EOPS, Roadrunner Hub & basic needs center.

#### Academic Affairs Senator: Transfer & General Education (1 position)

Focuses on matters related to academic departments, certificates, degrees, guided pathways, academic technology, distance education, library services, work experience, dual enrollment, athletics, child development, study abroad.

#### Academic Affairs Senator: Career & Technical Education (1 position)

Focuses on matters related to academic departments, certificates, degrees, guided pathways, academic technology, distance education, library services, work experience, dual enrollment, athletics, child development, and study abroad.

## STEP 2: Apply

Student Government at Butte College is made up of an elected Student Leadership Team and appointed Student Senators. Together these students work to represent and advocate for student interests, needs, and ideas.

#### Join the Student Leadership Team

The Leadership Team positions are elected through a student body election process. **Student Body elections will take place on April 23 – 25, 2024 online**.

Leadership Applications are due in BC Connect on April 8<sup>th</sup>, 2025.

#### **Become a Student Senator**

Senator positions are appointed by the Student Government Leadership Team through an application process after the Leadership Team is elected. Senators will be appointed on May 7<sup>th</sup>, 2024. Senator Applications are due in BC Connect on May 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2025.
